

Cascade Clamps

Cascade Clamp - Cascade Manufacturing Company was established in Portland, Oregon in 1943. They began as a small machine shop initially hiring 4 people. Sales for their first year of operation amounted to about \$60,000. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the machining and assembly of stainless steel valves, pipe fittings and various components. Through 5 years of operation, the company had expanded to 40 staff and their yearly sales volume had risen to three hundred thirty thousand dollars. Now, Cascade is one of the leading international makers within the material handling trade.

Manufacture and design of the company's first hydraulic cylinder paved the way in Cascade's aggressive pursuit of better business possibilities. During the past 60 years, the material handling trade has matured into a highly advanced field and Cascade has proudly performed a part in this progress. Cascade at the moment continues to develop as the best supplier of lift truck attachments and numerous related items. The business feels confident in their skill so as to continue to lead the way within the business by understanding customer's needs in the future and remaining aggressive within the global market.

During the nineteen fifties, Cascade began to fabricate, design, and promote its hydraulic accessories. A brand new facility was built in the year 1956, to be able to accommodate all the plant offices and operations in Portland, Oregon, which continues to be the company's current headquarters. Subsequent to fifteen years of business, total staff reached one hundred eighty employees and sales had reached almost two million three hundred thousand dollars.

In the year 1959 in Springfield, Gresham a second production plant was built. 1960 marked Cascade's preliminary transfer into the international world of the material handling industry as the business established interest in the Netherlands, England, and Australia.

In the year 1964, the company changed its name to the Cascade Corporation. Then in 1965, the company went public with a preliminary offering of 200,000 shares of common stock. Ever since then the company has expanded its manufacturing services within the continental USA to the places Warner Robins Georgia to go along with its already current plants in Portland, Oregon and Springfield, Gresham. Cascade merchandise are made globally because of many subsidiary operations. In 1994, a new plant was accomplished in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European head office. This plant is designed to be the essential customer service centre.

Cascade further expanded their product base in 1996 and 1997 after acquiring 5 firms, which included the Kenhar Corporation, the worldwide leader in blades.
